Athlete's Code of Conduct

I will be loyal to my teammates, to my coaches and the program. I will be supportive of the team both on the court/field and on the bench.

I will understand that learning/practice time in the gym is limited. I will be on time for practice and stay aware of what is being taught on the court/field.

I will respect and maintain what the program has provided for me: uniforms, equipment and practice areas.

I will show respect to all coaches, referees, committee members and other parents and guardians. Specifically, I will not talk back to these adults or talk badly about them on or off the court/field.

I understand that I am a representative of St. Celestine School on and off the court/field and my behavior should reflect our strong standards, including being alcohol and drug free. Inappropriate or abusive language has no place in the gymnasium (on the field) and I will choose not to use it. Improper language will not be tolerated on any level.

The procedure for dealing with improper language is as follows:

1. The first offense will result in a warning.
2. The second offense during the same game/activity will result in sitting out the rest of the game/activity.
3. Any additional usage during the same game/activity will result in further suspensions.
4. Repeated usage of improper language may result in suspensions or removal from a team game/activity.

I will overcome the urge to complain, think or act negatively, or take part in cliques.

On my own, I will supply the two basic items needed for a person to be called an **"athlete"**:
A good work ethic and a desire to compete.

I have read and understand the above Code of Conduct, and promise to abide by it to the best of my ability. I understand disciplinary action may be taken if my conduct falls outside of these guidelines.
