Dear St. Celestine School Parent,

You know when you walk through the doors at St. Celestine School, you are entering a truly special place. You are part of a family. You are part of a mission to provide the best possible education to students in the area.

Your tuition is an investment in your child's future. Last year's graduates were offered nearly \$90,000 in scholarships in area Catholic High Schools. We have a few students accepted into CPS Selective Enrollment High Schools. We are very proud of these young men and women and their success is just one measure of the success of our school.

Another measure is our continued strong performance on the *iReady* assessments. Our students performed well above the National Average and above the Archdiocesan Average in both Reading and Math. This indicates the strength in our educational performance and our resilience after the pandemic which changed the learning experience for some many children around the world.

Each year, it is our goal to ensure the cost to our families remains manageable. We recognize the challenges of inflation both to our families and to our school. Year to year costs continue to increase. We try to work with each of our families to provide what we can.

The average cost to educate students last year was \$6,457, while tuition for one child during the 2022/23 school year was \$5,763 per year, which includes the Curriculum Fee. This average accounts for sibling discounts and tuition assistance provided to families who qualify. That leaves a gap between what is spent and what is collected.

This gap is filled through fundraising and donations, as well as very careful management of school resources. We need our families, our alumni, our friends and other stakeholders to help fill that gap. We need your help now more than ever. With your assistance, you are not just making a donation, you are fulfilling a mission- the mission of excellent education!

Please continue to help with fundraisers, making your own donations, requesting outside donations and whatever you can as we continue to thrive and grow as a school. We are partners in a mission and are very blessed to have you.


