Dear Parents and Guardians:

As a reminder, St. Celestine School is closed for President's Day on February 16, 2026.

Parents who pick up students on Wellington should not double park or block the alley, as both create safety concerns. Please park in the parking lot and come around to Wellington or have your children meet you in the parking lot.

Registration continues. These are the steps to be registered.

- Online registration is available as the first step of the process.
- The \$125 per family registration fee must be paid.
- Families with new students registered must come to the office with an original Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate and registration fee.
- There is a referral program for new families. If a current family recommends a new family who registers and stays for at least the first trimester, the current family will get a \$300 reduction in tuition in April 2027.


