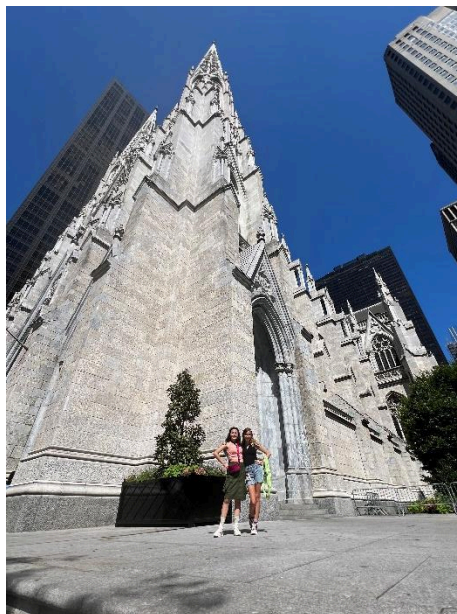
Please remember that the St. Mother Theodore Guerin Parish picnic is Saturday, July 28 starting at 10am at Evans Field in River Grove.
