Re: January 4-15, 2021 Child Care

Dear St. Celestine School Families,

Based on the Archdiocesan plan for a 2 week quarantine after Christmas, students will participate in remote learning from Monday, January 4 through Thursday, January 14, 2021. Students will return to face to face instruction on Tuesday, January 19, 2021. Friday, January 15 is a Teacher Professional Development Day and Monday, January 18, 2021 is the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday.

1. All students will move to Remote Learning at home from January 4 until January 14 to allow for a two week quarantine after Christmas break.
2. Teachers will provide live-streaming of instruction, with time allowed to complete assignments during the day. This will be similar to our two weeks of remote learning from November 30 until Dec. 11.
3. School supervision will be available for students from January 4 through January 14. Forty spots for students in PreK-8th grade will be available for child care. Supervision will be in a large space within the school building, such as the gym or lunchroom. All safety protocols will be utilized. The expectation is that students log into meetings and complete work while the child care is provided for them.

Breaks will be provided throughout the day for students. Students should bring books, coloring books, crayons and other items for breaks.

This child care option is available for families that have not traveled or participated in activities that would require them to quarantine. It is provided for parents whose work schedules do not allow them to be home during the school day and who have not been able to locate alternative care.
