Re: Adjustment to Thanksgiving and Christmas Schedule

Hello St. Celestine School Family

Thank you to everyone who completed the recent survey from the Archdiocesan Office of Catholic Schools.

Based on the input of all school stakeholders and the number of families traveling over the Thanksgiving holiday, and in discussion with the Archdiocesan Task Force and the OCS, St. Celestine School will implement the following schedule changes:

1. All students will move to Remote Learning at home from November 30 to December 11. Students will quarantine at home for November 30-December 11, with a face to face return on December 14 for face to face instruction.
2. Teachers will be on-site providing live-streaming of instruction, with time allowed to complete assignments during the day.
3. School supervision will be available for students from November 30 until December 11. Supervision will be in a large space within the school building, such as the gym or lunchroom. All safety protocols will be utilized. If you will need child supervision, please certify that you and your family did not travel for Thanksgiving by completing this Google form: <https://forms.gle/1jQkAAirnhxuDHBD9>
4. Christmas break will begin on December 18 at 11:30 and end on January 3.
5. As previously communicated, all students will move back to remote learning from January 4 through January 15, with the supervision option described in #3.
6. We will resume in-person learning and our current schedule on January 19.

As we approach Thanksgiving, I want to share my gratitude for our St. Celestine School teachers and staff members who have supported our students during this incredibly challenging year. I also share my appreciation to you, school families, who have been vigilant in your observance of safety behaviors in and outside of school.
