Dear Parents,

This week, I have a very important update from the Archdiocese of Chicago. Based on a review of the cohort model, the Archdiocese has taken a look at when schools may accept remote learning students back into the face-to-face classroom. After the start of October, schools must not allow returns until the end of their first marking period.

Consequently, if you are a remote learner family and are contemplating a return, please contact me at sklich@stcelestineschool.org by the end of this week. Any return must be done by Monday, October 6. After that, the soonest a child may return is November 7.

Another thing the Archdiocese is encouraging is that families get flu shots. Given the concerns over the flu and COVID happening at the same time, the flu shot is of far greater importance than in years past.

Lastly, for those of you who use the parking lot, please drive slowly and carefully. We are using the entrances of the parking lot more frequently and are using the lot for recess time. There is a lot more pedestrian traffic than in the past and we need everyone to prioritize safety.
